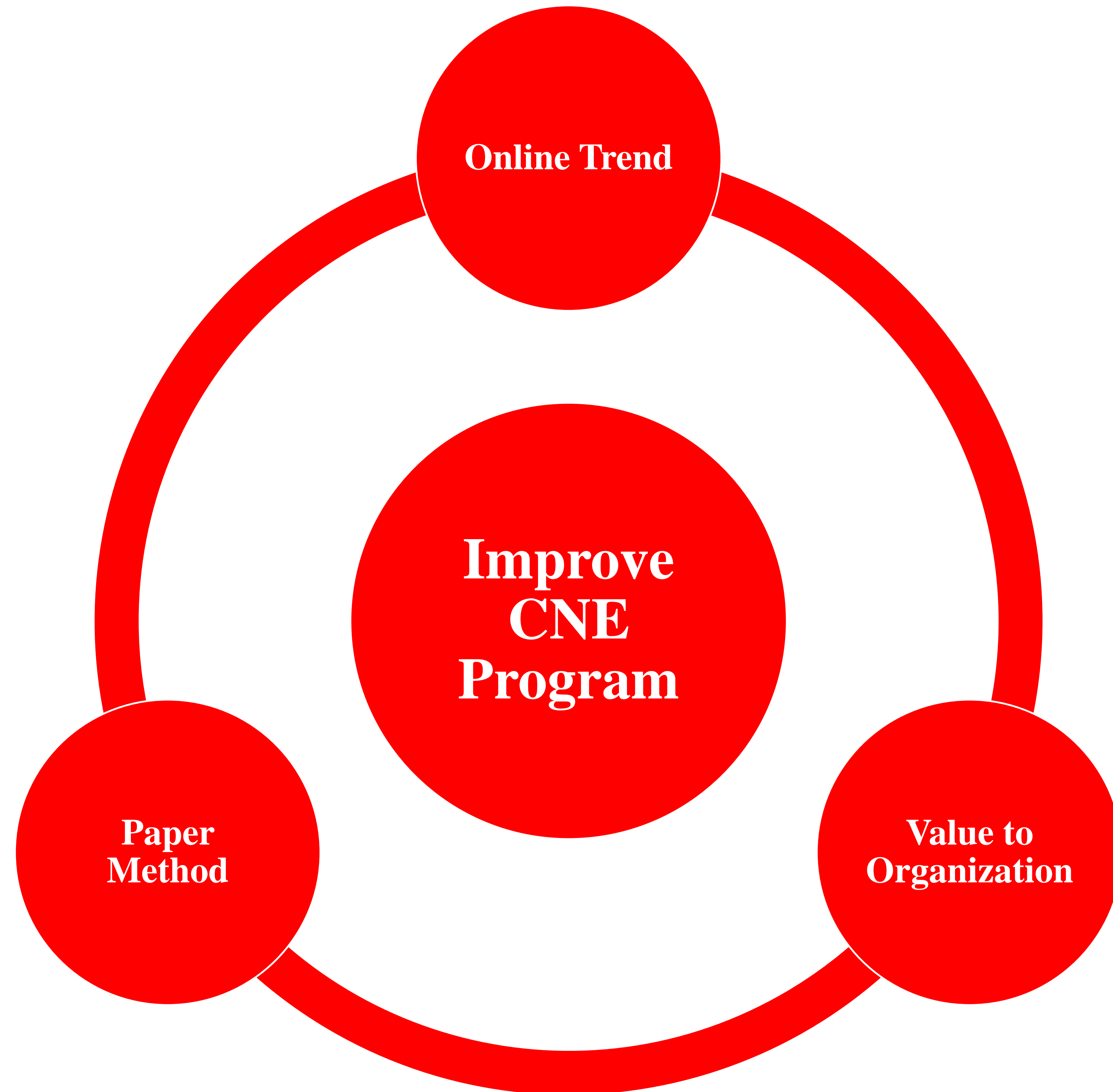
Background

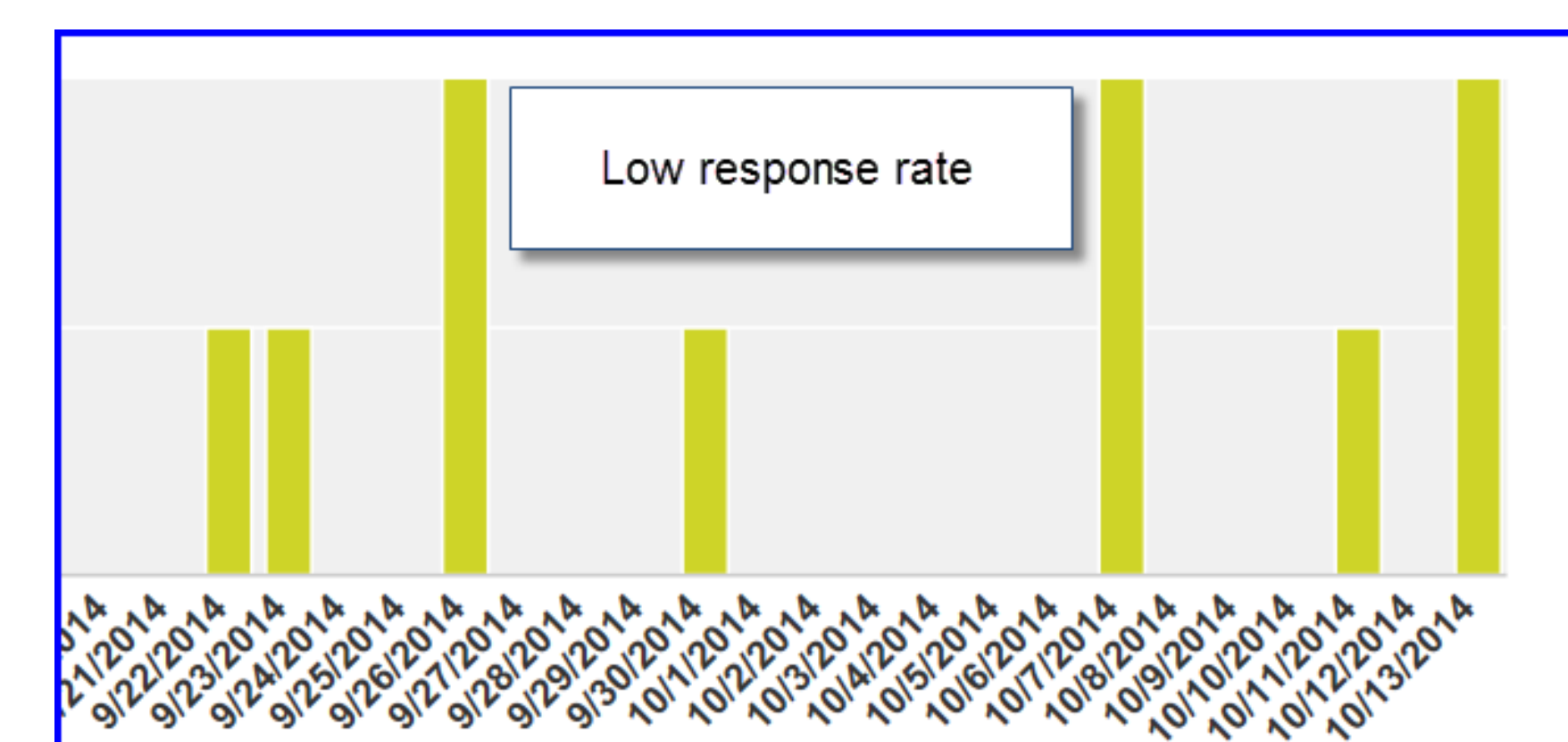
- Learner feedback: add question about online method versus paper documentation

- Inclusion of attendance sheets if the learner is not a RN

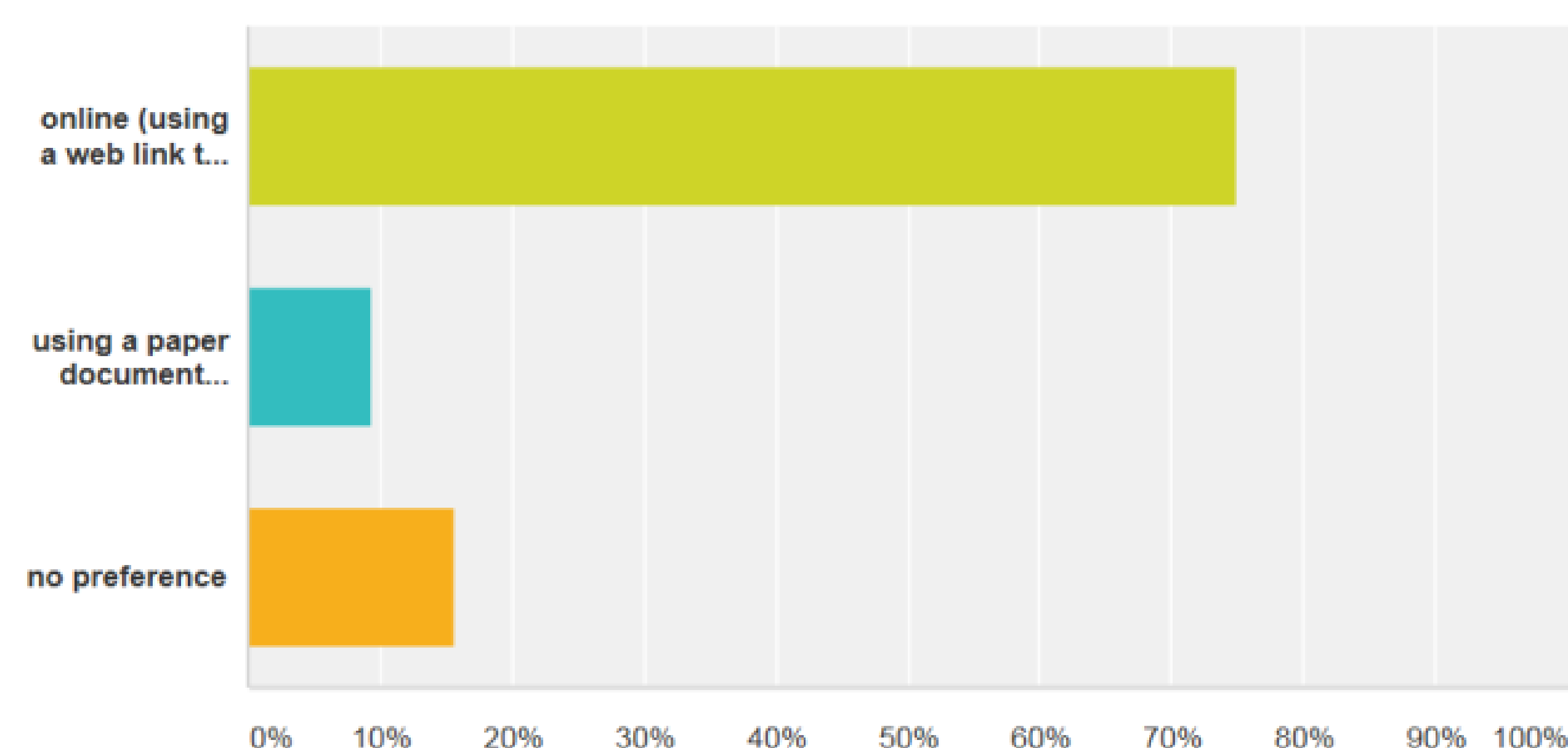

Project Aims

Identify the emerging trend to use an on-line evaluation method for CNE programs.

Compare and contrast the usage of an on-line CNE program evaluation method versus a paper document format.

Evaluate the organizational benefits of using an electronic method to obtain CNE program evaluation data

Methods

PDSA 1: March 2014

- The LNA directed a process improvement project of utilizing an online evaluation method. Literature review and consultations with local Primary Nurse Planners supported usage of online evaluation process; a subscription to SurveyMonkey® was purchased.

PDSA 2: May 15, 2014

- The Primary Nurse Planner developed the online survey format and updated the disclosure form with instructions to accessing the online evaluation and certificate of successful completion. A pilot group was selected based upon ability to follow instructions with developing the CNE documentation packet.

PDSA 3: June 11, 2014

- Develop survey questions to capture learner perspective of utilizing online method versus paper method and future CNE program suggestions. Continued to place onto other evaluations to capture learner perspectives

PDSA 4: August 19, 2014

- Partner with Information Services to research available online programs

PDSA 5: September 13, 2014

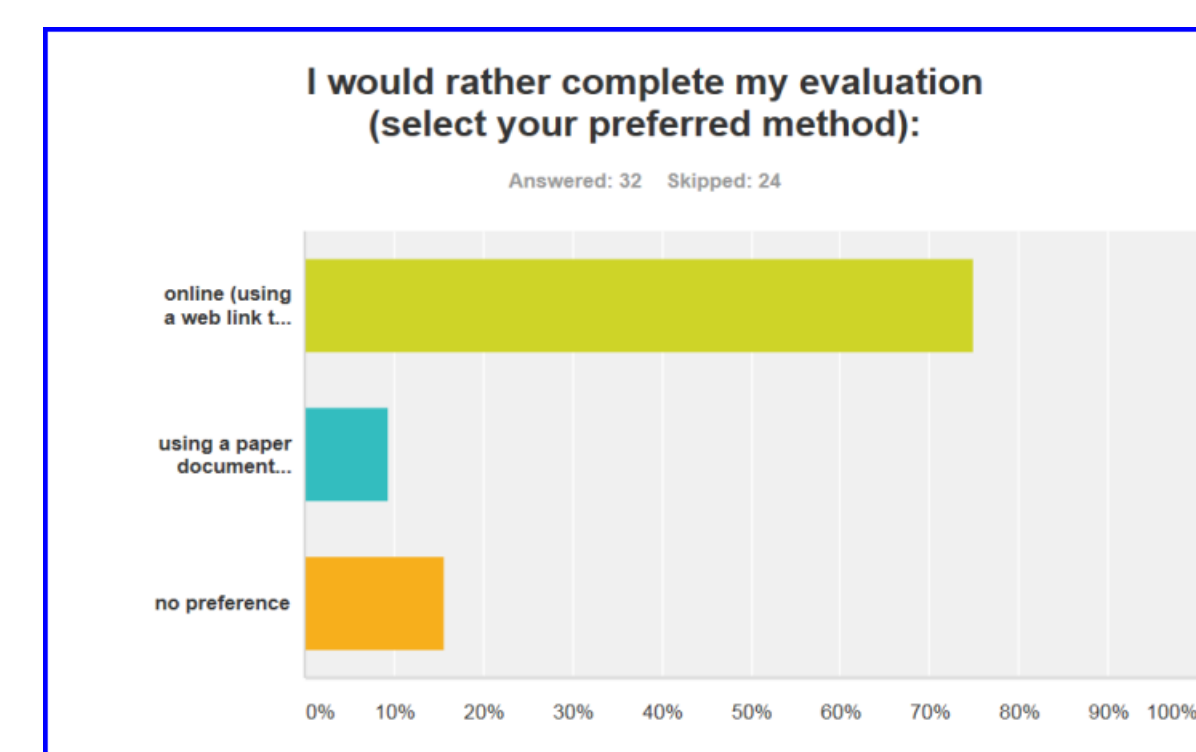
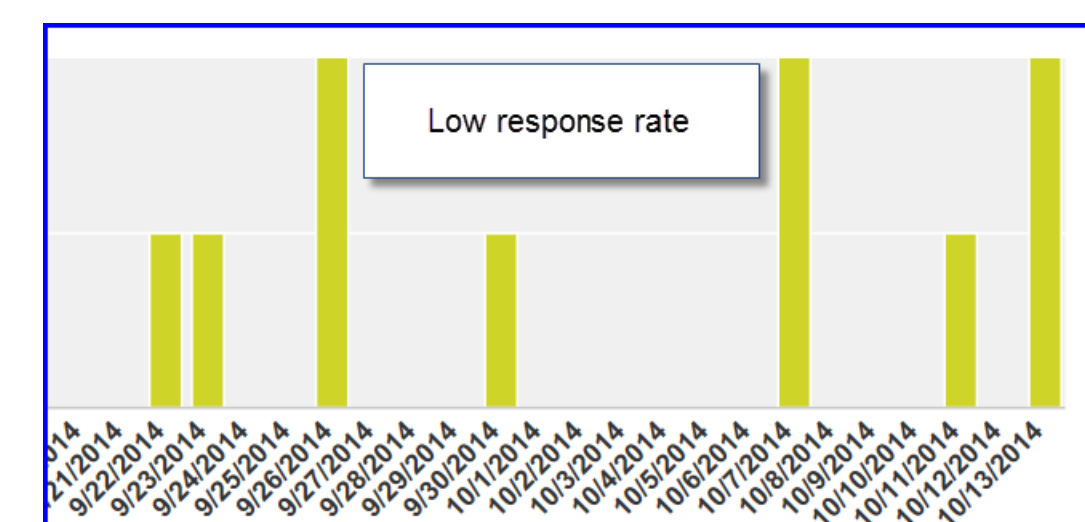
- Ensure web link does not have an underscore between words as learner may miss this when typing

Results

- Since May 15th 19 CNE programs have used online method
- Learners have indicated overall support of transitioning to online evaluation process
- Tabulation time has decreased
- Able to utilize for broadcasted program
- Occasional low response rates
- Inclusion of other professional discipline certificates of successful completion
- Inclusion of attendance sheets if the learner is not a RN

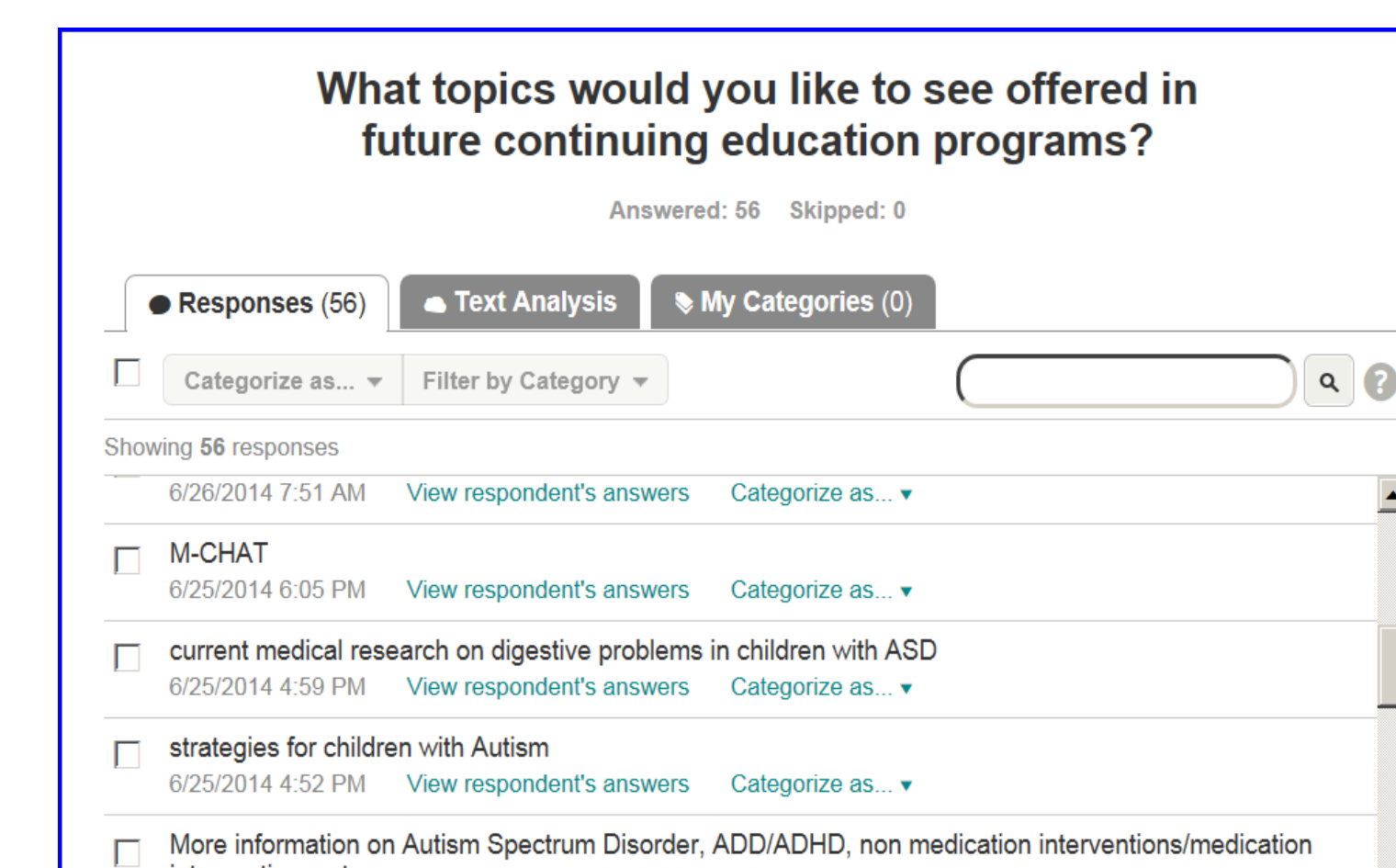
Discussion

BENEFITS

- Leadership support is essential
- Purchase of technologically advance program will enable all evaluations to be placed online
- Automation capabilities extend to other CNE documentation requirements
- Interdisciplinary partnerships
- Productivity increased with tabulation time
- Online evaluation saves on postage cost approximately
- Future topics questions is capturing support for additional CNE programs

LESSONS LEARNED

- Select setting for mandatory answer
- Not everyone expresses comfort utilizing online method
- Online transition is a long term endeavor
- Determine a completion deadline
- Strong communication to ensure evaluation is correct in case of speaker change
- Separating RN response data
