Financial Assistance Summary



Cook Children's works to deliver compassionate, high-quality, affordable health care services to its patients. Financial assistance is available to eligible patients and families that are uninsured, underinsured, ineligible for a government program, or otherwise unable to pay for medically necessary care based on their financial situation.

Cook Children's financial assistance policy provides detailed information about the process for obtaining financial assistance, the eligibility criteria and the types of assistance available. Who is eligible?

All patients are eligible to apply for financial assistance, including those with insurance. We use established guidelines to determine who qualifies and the amount of their discount.

- Uninsured or underinsured patients with family income at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) will receive a 100% discount off billed charges.
- Uninsured patients with family income greater than 400%, up to 500% of FPG, and whose medical bills exceed 5% of their yearly income are eligible for a discount of between 85% to 70% off billed charges.
- Patients with family income over 500% of FPG and whose medical bills exceed 35% of their yearly income, and insured patients whose medical bills after payments by their insurer(s) exceed 35% of their yearly income, are eligible for a discount of between 55% to 90% off billed charges.

A person who is eligible for financial assistance will never be charged more for emergency or other medically necessary care than the amounts generally billed to individuals with insurance.
